


Community outreach models

CORPORATE PHILANTHROPY

Focus area: Empowerment and gender equality

Dignity For Work (DWF) at Latur district:

We tied up with Goonj for development projects in Latur through the DFW program. The project encourages collective action from local participants in areas of environment, healthcare, education and sanitation, and rewards the village residents with livelihood kits in return.

Total contribution: INR 30 Lacs



Focus area: Healthcare

1. World-class Hospital ICU wards:

We have set up 10 Bed ICU wards at Sarojini Devi Hospital, Hyderabad with the support of Nirmaan organization. A part of the fund was donated by our employees which was matched by the organization to help amplify the hospital's efforts toward offering quality care for below poverty line patients.

Total contribution: INR 31.30 Lacs

2. Improving healthcare facilities in rural India:

Tiruvalangadu has been identified by the Govt. of India as a uniformly low-ranking block in areas such as healthcare. Partnering with Thuvakkam NGO, we provided healthcare equipment like portable ECG machines.

Total contribution: INR 1.27 Lacs





Focus area: Education

1. Firstsource Scholarship Program (FSP):

In 2017, we partnered with Foundation For Excellence (FFE) NGO to sponsor five deserving students from underrepresented backgrounds to pursue engineering studies. All five students have completed their BTech and are placed with eminent corporates. Based on the project's success, we renewed our partnership with FFE and have identified 12 students across six states to sponsor their engineering studies.

Total contribution: 5.28 Lacs/Year (For next four years)

2. Project Annando:

Like every year, we supported the Light of Life Trust to help 21 students in Rajasthan to receive regular curricular/co-curricular academic training and enhance their learning outcomes.

Total contribution: 0.2 Lacs







We supported Ek Kadam Aur NGO to recognize teaching coordinators across India for conducting virtual/physical training programs for children who have the fewest resources.

Total contribution: 0.46 Lacs

4. Transforming community learning:

We partnered with Transforming Rural India Foundation (TRIF) to implement a six-month community learning center program in Petlavad district, Madhya Pradesh and improve learning outcomes for 400 primary students.

Total contribution: 12.50 Lacs





Focus area: Environment

1. Urban Forest (phase 1) project at Chennai and Hyderabad:

Joining the global movement to combat climate change, we partnered with Thuvakkam NGO to create two urban forest sites with 1200 saplings planted in each site at Chennai and Hyderabad. The funding includes two years' maintenance of the saplings to help build dense forests and increase biodiversity of cities.

Total contribution: 10.44 Lacs

2. Urban Forest (phase 2) project at Mumbai and Bengaluru:

Phase 2 of the project was executed with another 1200 saplings planted in each site at Mumbai and Bengaluru and also included funding for two years' maintenance of the saplings like phase 1.

Total contribution: 10.80 Lacs





Driving the Digital First, Digital Now agenda

1. Digital skilling of rural women artisans:

In partnership with Nasscom Foundation, we identified 150 women artisans from Bagh District who will undergo one year of training under the Upskilling Women Artisan Entrepreneurship, Financial & Digital Skilling Program. This training aims to narrow down the digital divide for women entrepreneurs from marginalized communities and improve their income potential and well-being.

Total contribution: INR 38.77 Lacs

2. Annie – Smart Lab setup:

We collaborated with Donate Kart and Thinkerbell team to set up a unique digital lab at The Karnataka Welfare Association for Blind premises in Bengaluru. The lab has 10 of the world's first digital self-learning braille literacy devices 'Annie' to empower visually impaired students.

Total contribution: INR 10.34 Lacs





We support GiveIndia as part of the Firstsource employee giving program and enabled them to upgrade technology infrastructure and improve the crowdfunding platform's performance.



IMPACT SOURCING


Impact Sourcing is a business practice where a company prioritizes suppliers that intentionally hire and provide career development opportunities to people who otherwise have limited prospects for formal employment.

Firstsource promotes Impact Sourcing by including it as a criterion in our procurements RFPs and awarding points to suppliers who hire through Impact Sourcing. All other things equal, Impact Sourcing is a deciding factor for suppliers competing for business. Our suppliers currently engage over 2000 impact workers on behalf of Firstsource and maintain a scorecard in line with the Global Impact Sourcing Coalition (GISC) parameters which they submit to us periodically.

Earlier in 2021, Firstsource followed a traditional model of hiring through consultants. Later, the Talent Acquisition (TA) team in collaboration with the CSR function started working with non-profits

and partners to provide socially responsible employment.

Collaborating with NGOs, sourcing partners and government organizations across Asia, the US and Europe we have created 4000+ opportunities for socially responsible employment and our goal is to hire and our goal is to hire 10,000 impact workers by 2025.



IMPACT SOURCING SUCCESS STORIES

During the second wave and third of COVID-19 in India, we received a customer support request from NASSCOM Foundation for a Bengaluru COVID-19 helpline run by Project STEPONE, a volunteer effort to boost government resources in the pandemic. As part of Impact Sourcing, our TA and CSR team onboarded a few LGBQTIA+ candidates successfully who are supporting the operations for the Karnataka COVID19 Follow Up and Vaccination Helpline till today.

We received another similar request from our nonprofit partner Chennai Volunteers during the third wave. Similar to the Bengaluru batch, our Chennai TA and CSR team hired a few candidates from the LGBQTIA+ community in collaboration with Tiruvallur Health Department officials.

Both helplines handled calls for over 7700 patients in two months, enabling the government to efficiently manage and reduce the spread of COVID19 in both regions. We take pride in harnessing the capabilities of these candidates wanting to make a mark, irrespective of their perceived disadvantages, and building a meaningful and mutually beneficial career with us.

Skill development sessions with ICT Academy

ICT ACADEMY, an Initiative of Government of India, State Government and Industry reached out to Firstsource to conduct expert sessions on various skills required in today's industry such as machine learning, and career opportunities in banking and finance to undergraduate students across PAN India. Many of our business and corporate function leaders participated in the skill-building virtual sessions for student communities.

Working towards creating safer cities

To reduce cybercrimes against women, the Cyberabad Police Society and the Cyberabad Security Council have developed an e-learning module on women safety through the SHESafe app. We introduced the virtual learning awareness module of Safety Awareness for Employees (SAFE) for all women employees in

Firstsource Hyderabad office in collaboration with Society of Cyberabad Security Council (SCSC) on International Women's Day. The session was led by Namratha Reddy, VP -Operations, Firstsource and SCSC woman forum leader.




CSR Leadership Award




